

## CONSERVATION OF BIODIVERSITY

Upper Assam being one of the most diverse regions in the world for flora & fauna, our tea estates play a key role in the conservation of the local eco system. Initiatives such as creating biodiversity spots within the plantation, unsuitable for agriculture, help in the restoration of the depleting ecosystem. These biodiversity spots provide habitats for wildlife living on the estates, or that pass through them during migration. Hunting & capturing wild animals & birds are prohibited in the estates. Awareness is created among the local tea community regarding the conservation of biodiversity for a more sustainable environment.

## OUR ESTATES

**MANCOTTA** – Meaning the place where the Burmese were defeated, this tea estate is located between the Dibrugarh town & the Jokai reserved forest. Amidst the beautiful plantation where some of the **best orthodox teas** that the country has to offer, visitors can pamper themselves with the unforgettable comfort & experience of the colonial lifestyle in the “Mancotta Heritage Bungalow”

**JALANNAGAR** – The historic John Berry White Medical college, now known as the Assam Medical College is surrounded by this estate. Originally known as the Borbari Tea Estate, within the Dibrugarh town, is home to the company’s head office. The lush green plantations offer a serene atmosphere within the hustle & bustle of the city.

**LIMBUGURI** – This mark is a synonym for **fine Assam ctc & orthodox teas**. Neighbouring the Dibru Saikhowa national park, this estate is a haven for bird lovers. This estate, with its natural beauty, rich biodiversity & mesmerising tea walks, offers a perfect escape for city dwellers. The “Wathai” Heritage Bungalow is located in this estate.

**MUKUL** – An **organic garden** where visitors can have a hands-on experience of plucking & making their own handmade green tea. Lush bamboo & banana plantations along with a variety of bird population adds to an unforgettable experience.

**ETHELWOLD** – Located near the banks of the Brahmaputra in Dibrugarh, this picturesque garden has some of the **best ctc teas** to offer. This garden originally established by a British planter, is named after his daughter Ethel.

**BAUGHPARA** – Also located between the Dibrugarh town & the Jokai reserved forest, its name means the landing place of cranes . The common species found here are the Adjutant Storks and Bubulcus Ibis.
